Our response

Please see the attached spreadsheet. The data shows those who attained SJT 1-3, had a total UKCAT score of 2500 or less, and received an interview and/or offer.

The answers also took into account deferred entry applicants, but none were offered or interviewed under this criteria.

This completes the university's response to your information request.
