Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act ('the Act') of 31/08/2013, seeking:

'It is reported in the Guardian that Ms Lucy Adams has instructed lawyers to counter claims made by the NUJ.

Can you please tell me if these lawyers are employed by or being paid for by the BBC? Will the BBC be covering, in any way, Ms Adams' legal costs?

As the NUJ article made serious and damaging allegations against Lucy Adams in her role as the BBC's Director of Human Resources, the BBC has agreed to fund the reasonable costs of Ms Adams seeking external legal advice.

The funding currently covers the provision of legal advice to Ms Adams prior to the issue of proceedings and her lawyer's costs must be approved by the BBC in advance in incremental caps, with an explanation of the work that needs to be undertaken.

Appeal Rights

If you are not satisfied that we have complied with the Act in responding to your request, you have the right to an internal review by a BBC senior manager or legal adviser. If you are not satisfied with the internal review, you can appeal to the Information
