## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 - REQUEST 2181

Thank you for your request for information, which we received on 12 November 2021. You asked us;

- 1. How many malicious emails have been successfully blocked?
- 2. What percentage of malicious emails were opened by staff?
- 3. What percentage of malicious links in the emails were clicked on by staff?
- 4. How many ransomware attacks were blocked by the department?
- 5. How many ransomware attacks were successful?

The date range for the requests is from 2018 to present day. The data shall include a breakdown by year and by individual departments (e.g. separate departments, agencies, or public bodies within the main government agency), if applicable.

Your request will be considered and you will receive information to which you are entitled within the statutory timescale of 20 working days.

The Act contains a number of exemptions that permit us to restrict the disclosure of information. If any exemption does apply to your request, it is possible that some or all of the information will not be released. If this is the case, you will be informed, and told about your right of appeal. In any case we will always try to assist you as much as possible with your request.
