## Request under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002

"Dear Glasgow City Council, I'd like to request a copy of a map or a descriptive breakdown of the boundaries of each district within the Glasgow City Council area. To clarify I am NOT requesting a council Ward breakdown, as these are often different to the historic district areas. Instead i'm requesting details of exactly where the council believes the boundaries of districts such as Bellahouston, Dumbreck, Govan, Merchant City, Partick and other areas are within the city. The council is treating your request as a request under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

On inspecting our records, it would appear that Glasgow City Council does not hold the information which you have requested. Neither does anyone else hold it on our behalf as we do not have the City broken down into district boundaries or localities. Any operational boundaries are service specific and used for internal Council purposes. Therefore this information would be exempt under Section 17 of the Act. That is to say that the information is not held by the council. Accordingly we are unable to comply with your request.

If/...

If you are dissatisfied with the way Glasgow City Council has dealt with your request you are entitled to require the Council to review its decision. Please note that for a review to take place you must:

- Lodge a written requirement for a review within 40 working days of the date of this letter
- Include a correspondence address and a description of the original request and the reason why you are dissatisfied
- Address your request to the Executive Director of Corporate Services:

You will receive notice of the results of the review within 20 working days of receipt of your request. The notice will state the decision reached by the reviewing officer as well as details of how to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner if you are still dissatisfied with the Council's response. You must request an internal review by the Council before a complaint can be directed to the Scottish Information Commissioner.

If you wish to submit a complaint to the Council in relation to the manner in which it has handled your request for information you can do so by requesting that the Council review its decision. Details of how to request a review are set out in the above paragraph "Right of Review".
