4. Furthermore, please confirm if a timetable can be provided for academic year 2019/20 and confirm the duration of course?
5. Is the Master of Business Administration delivered via online/distance learning?
6. If so, please confirm the total fee of the course and how long to take the course?

Our Response

1. Yes, the University delivers an MBA.
2. Leadership and Management in Healthcare MBA and Education Leadership and Management MBA are delivered at weekends.
3. The fees for 19/20 were:
 - Home/EU - £13,455 for the full course
 - Overseas - £13,455 for the full courseThe fees for 20/21 will be:
 - Home/EU - £14,925 for the full course
 - Overseas - £14,925 for the full course.
4. 2019/20 timetables for both MBAs are attached as Annex 1. Both courses are 1year full time.
5. The University does not provide an MBA via distance learning.
