Thank you for your email dated 5 May 2014, in which you asked for an internal review into the way the department handled your request for information under reference: FOI 89986

During the FOI request internal review, please reconsider the following requests, bearing in mind they have already been disclosed by suppliers press release, media & press reports, social media posts by staff etc, automated data gathering, meta data in web pages and information held by other government agencies. This would mean the FOIA section 24 exemption may not be valid but may actually be section 21.

i) Please state if the source data recording these form submissions are in text log files located on the file system, database files or socket based (ie SQL) database (please explicitly state how this form data is stored).

ii) Please state the hardware platform, architecture, operating system for this server along with the vendor and product name of the web server application listening on TCP port https.

I understand section 24 refusal is standard government guidance and training given to public bodies and in the past has been given for information that was already on government websites.

Your request has been passed to me because I will be responsible for handling the internal review.

Your request is being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

The department will be conducting a review and a response will be issued to you by 03 June 2014.

In your reply of 5th May 2014, you indicated that information had been released. I would be grateful if you could give me the specific sources (ideally website addresses) of this information by 14 May 2014 so I can give my full response to your request.
