



The information in this pricing section of the document is being withheld because it is exempt under section 43(2) FOIA. Section 43(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 provides that: "Information is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to, prejudice the commercial interests of any person (including the public authority holding it)". The Council has consulted with Mears Ltd with regard to this request and having considered the response agree that the, disclosure of the information would be likely to prejudice the commercial interests of the Service Provider. The company operates in a competitive market place and the pricing information would be of value to the company's competitors in preparing future competitive tenders.

The exemption under s 43 FOIA is a qualified exemption. That is to say that, notwithstanding the application of the exemption, the Council must still be satisfied that the public interest in withholding the information is greater than the public interest in disclosing it.

The Council acknowledges the public interest in transparency and accountability in the spending of public money. This is recognised by the disclosure of all items of expenditure over £500.00. However there are significant benefits to the Council which, as it must, operates in the commercial world, in respecting the right of confidentiality in respect of individual pricing structures so that contractors feel confident in putting their best prices forward in competitive situations so that the council can obtain best value for money.

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). In accordance with Section 1 of the FOIA I confirm that the Council does hold the information you have requested.

The contract has been reviewed and the decision is to release the document to you subject to the withholding of the pricing section. A copy of this document will be sent to on a CD, by post to your home address.

The information in this pricing section of the document is being withheld because it is exempt under section 43(2) of the FOIA. Section 43(2) of the FOIA provides that: "Information is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to, prejudice the commercial interests of any person (including the public authority holding it)". The Council has consulted with Mears Ltd with regard to this request and having considered the response agree that the, disclosure of the information would be likely to prejudice the commercial interests of the Service Provider. The company operates in a competitive market place and the pricing information would be of value to the company's competitors in preparing future competitive tenders.

The exemption under section 43(2) of the FOIA is a qualified exemption. That is to say that, notwithstanding the application of the exemption, the Council must still be satisfied that the public interest in withholding the information is greater than the public interest in disclosing it.

The Council acknowledges the public interest in transparency and accountability in the spending of public money. This is recognised by the disclosure of all items of expenditure over £500.00. However there are significant benefits to the Council which, as it must, operates in the commercial world, in respecting the right of confidentiality in respect of individual pricing structures so that contractors feel confident in putting their best prices forward in competitive situations so that the council can obtain best value for money.

After considering the arguments outlined above, I have concluded that the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosure of the pricing information in the requested document.


