Year	Threshold for interview
2013	37 points
2014	38 points (plus some students with 37 point)
2015	38 points (plus some students with 37 points)
2016	37 points (or 36 points plus ABBB at AS-level)
2017	34 points and above
2018	30 points and above
2019	32* points and above
2020	30* points and above

*Please note from 2019 grades B and C were scored for the first time and therefore the threshold is not directly comparable with previous years.
