Dear All,

We would like to alert you of the fact that the initial notes from the 19 February meeting in Riga, which were sent out on 3 March for your comments and for filling in the Matrix, **have been leaked in a falsified form**. The blog bases itself on one sentence from the document which you will not find in the original. The fake sentence is inserted under chapter 3 "Challenges for Ukraine" – listing the "Increased popularity of the Russian leadership among the population of the south/east of the country" as if it was one of the challenges discussed and noted during the meeting. Also, you will note that only Dr. Tatham's name has been left on the document as Point of Contact.

The post was published on 1 April and to our knowledge it has not gained any media traction, hence we have decided not to react in order not to create unnecessary attention to the leaked and falsified document.
