Request

I have noted that in their latest list of members the BPA (British Parking Association) lists yourselves:

The BPA is not a highly regarded organisation by many motorists and seen as ineffective in regulating the private parking operators who make up the bulk of its membership; MPs in the House of Commons have also echoed these concerns.

- How it benefits your residents by being a member.
- Benefits received by being a member of the BPA.
- The annual costs for being a member of the BPA.

Response

The exact record and documentation of the date is not known. However, an employee of the Council who has been a member of the Parking Services Team for many years is of the opinion that the Council joined the BPA in the late 1990s.
