Re: your application under the Freedom of Information Act for information regarding admissions under 25

I am writing in respect of your recent enquiry for information held by Barnet, Enfield and Haringey Mental Health Trust under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 received on 14 June 2017.

You requested the following information:

I am writing to request the number of patients under the age of 25 admitted for mental health related issues in the past three years, under the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

That is, the number admitted in 2017; the number admitted in 2016; and the number admitted in 2015.

I would also like to request the figures broken down per month. That is, a total for the year, then the figures broken down for each month.

We have dealt with your request under section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act which entitles you to be provided with any information held by a public authority, unless an appropriate exemption applies.
