The Year the Police Vehicle was commissioned/Year Model of the Vehicle (If you don't know or have the information about the Police Vehicle's Year Model, that's OK. Just the Year when the Police Vehicle was commissioned)

Years:1990, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 or 2005

The Year when the Police Vehicle was Decommissioned

Marked or Unmarked Vehicle

Unmarked Vehicle Color (If you can't give me the information or don't have the information, that's OK, just the commissioned/model year, decommissioned year, make and model)

Role of the Vehicle

Area/General Purpose Vehicle, Armed Response Vehicles (ARV), Cell/Prisoner Transporter Vehicle, Dog Section Vehicle, Incident Response Police Support Unit

Vehicle, Prisoners Transporter Vehicle, etc..If the Police Vehicle has a video camera or not (If you don't know about this information, that's OK)

Police Vehicle Body Structure

Type of Vehicle (Cars) (Coupe, Estate/Caravan/Wagon, Hatchback Liftback, Saloon/Sedan etc...)

Vans (Combi, Minibus, Panel Van) Wheelbase (Long, Medium, Short) Roof Size (High, Low, Medium or Jumbo) Number of Tires (4,6 or 10 Tires)

Number of Doors on the Police Vehicle

Example: 2-Door, 3-Door, 4-Door, 5-Door, etc...

Number of that Specific Police Vehicle

Random Example: We had 12 1993 Vauxhall Cavalier Saloon in the Ministry of Defence Police Force.

Photos of each Police Vehicle (If not available, that's OK)

Question: For the information officer who give me this fleet information is that all the Police Vehicle in the Ministry of Defence Police Fleet or that just the vehicles you do know or able to get, meaning you don't know all of the Police Vehicles?"

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do not hold information in scope of your request.
