I write in connection with your request for information received on 14 February 2017.
You asked:

Q1. Could I request a blank copy of a missing persons or MISPER form?

A. Surrey Police do not hold a blank missing persons or misper form. In the event of a missing person, a missing /absent report is created within our crime reporting system which would be completed by an officer. This includes a risk assessment and a set of questions.

Surrey Police provides you the right to request a re-examination of your case under its review procedure. How to do this is set out in the attached Appeals Notice. Having followed the full procedure, if you are still dissatisfied, then you have the right to direct your comments to the Information Commissioner who will give your case consideration.
