(MOD), therefore we have amalgamated the requests. A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held. Please see below for information you have requested.

# **Telephone System**

1. What is your current telephony system?

The core telephony system is via BT with Unify, Siemens and Nortel PABX in the distributed PABX estate. The VoIP service is Skype for Business.

2. How many users of the telephony system?

The Core system has circa 200,000 extensions. The VoIP system has circa 195,000 extensions.

3. When is the contract up for renewal?

The base contract completes in September 2020, with two one-year options available from September 2020.

4. Approximate annual spend?

Approximate annual spend is £45M.

5. If it isn't a VoIP system, will that be a consideration for the next contract cycle?

Not applicable.

The MOD uses EE via BT.

The MOD has approx.. 55,000 mobile connections.

The current contract was initially for 5 years with two one-year options to extend.
