Your request was received on 29 July 2021 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').

You asked:

I am requesting a spreadsheet of the maximum moderation percentages applicable to a raw mark in the physics exams at your university (for the academic year 2020/21) and if possible the future assessment plan for the academic year 2021/22.

This information is not held. Any information about the moderation of marks is contained within examiners' reports, not all of which have been created for this year, and the 2021/22 assessment plan has not been created.
