I would like the following:

- Total number of grants issued for electric two wheelers since the scheme was launched
- Total amount of money spent by the government in grants for electric two wheelers
- A month by month break down of the number of grants issued for electric two wheelers since the scheme was launched.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

I am writing to advise you that the Motorcycle Plug-in Grant is not yet operational and therefore the information you requested is not held by this Department.

Appeals procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original request and should be addressed to the Information Rights Unit:
