Your request was received on 8 October 2018 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').


## You asked:

- Q2. Please provide the number of full time teaching staff on MPhil in Health, Medicine and Society for academic year 2017-2018.
- Q2.[3] Please provide the budget for MPhil in Health, Medicine and Society for academic year 2017-2018.
- Q3.[4] Please provide the university budget on education for for academic year 2017-2018.
- 1. There were 11 students in 2017-18.
- 2. There are no dedicated full time staff for this course. We have derived an estimate based on the number of staff who have teaching responsibilities for this course, multiplied by the estimated FTE time spent teaching on the course. We estimate the equivalent of 6 full time teaching staff.
- 3. The budget for 2017-18 was £237,600.
