Under the FOIA I wish to request the following information –

Copies of all written (electronic and paper) agreements (contracts and emails) which indicate and/or approve a discounted chargeable rate between the Local Authority Land Charges office for compiled local search reports and the National Land Information Service (NLIS) which is now known as Land Data.
