Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the Sheffield City Region Combined Authority has now completed its search for the information which you requested by e-mail on 20 October 2017

Your questions and my findings are as follows:-

- 1. I understand that you've been awarded funds from the National Productivity Investments Fund. Please could you provide me with all the bids that you submitted including any appendices and supporting documents submitted alongside the bids?**

Please find below descriptions of the information requested, separated by the Local Authority the bids fall under. The information is attached to the covering email. Some information has been redacted and is detailed where in the table below. The exemptions applied are as follows:

Section 22 – Where Section 22 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 has been applied it is because this information is intended for future publication. The schemes the bids are for are still in their infancy and as such the information held is not ready for publication. There is no set date for publication but it will be when the details of the scheme are finalised.

Section 40(2) – Where Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 has been applied this is because the information is third party personal information, and disclosure of such information would breach the first Data Protection Principle.

Section 43(2) – Where Section 43(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 has been applied this is because release of the information would likely prejudice the commercial interests of Sheffield City Council.


