I write in response to your Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('FoIA 2000') request, dated 11/06/2021, in which you requested:

"Please provide me with the following NCALT e-learning packages:

Anti-Social Behaviour: Your Powers Channel General Awareness Display Screen Equipment (DSE) e-learning Equality Act 2010 Fire Safety e-learning Freedom of Information Manual Handling e-learning Missing Daughter National Decision Model for Policing Public Protection – Abusive Relationship Public Protection – Family Disturbance Public Protection – Man in Distress Stop and Search Stop and Search Assessment Transportation of Arrested Persons Victims' Code Workplace Safety E-learning"

Decision

We are currently considering your request. The Act allows us to exceed the 20 working day response target where we are dealing with a qualified exemption that requires us to consider the public interest test. This test is used to balance the public interest in favour of disclosure against the public interest in favour of withholding the information.

The information that you have requested is being considered in line with the following exemptions under the FoIA:

- Section 31 – Law enforcement
- Section 43 – Commercial interests.

These are qualified exemptions and we estimate to consider the public interest test fully, we may need up to 20 extra working days. We will aim to issue a response to you as soon as possible within that time period.
