## Request

Please provide for the following financial years: 2016/17 2017/18 2018/19 (for the period April to 03 May)

- 1) Internal records, approval details, and paid invoices (where external) or administrative staff costings/hours (where internal) for batches of physical documents/ files destroyed via paper shredding by Newham Council
- 2) Detailed (descriptors) of batches of physical documents/ files destroyed via paper shredding by Newham Council;
- 3) Detailed (descriptors) of batches of physical documents/ files lists of documents rejected for paper shredding



For electronic files, please provide

- 4) Internal records, approval details, and paid invoices (where external) or administrative staff costings/hours (where internal) for batches of electronic files destroyed by Newham Council
- 5) Details (descriptors) of batches of digital files permanently deleted from LB Newham systems

## Response

1. We do not centrally record this information and it would exceed the appropriate limit as set under Section 12 of the FOI Act to compile this data for the whole Council for the purpose of this FOI. Services maintain their own records and from the search we have conducted for one service, it is apparent an officer would need to cross match the information we hold on the destroyed files with other data and systems to provide you with all of the detailed information you have requested.

Under the Freedom of Information Act the Council has a right to refuse a request for information held if the cost of complying with a request exceeds the appropriate limit. The appropriate limit for local authorities is £450 or 2.5 days or 18 hours. We believe in this case such an exemption applies and has decided to refuse your request for information under section 12(1) of the Act.

- 12 Exemption where cost of compliance exceeds appropriate limit
- (1) Section 1(1) does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit.
