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Sorry if I am going to use terminology you may be unfamiliar with -

Emergency is a very emotive word.

Twenty four hour operation will allow the well to be partially abandoned with a reduced risk of complications. Daylight hours only operations will require the well to be shut in during the night. There is a risk, albeit low, that in this situation further hydrocarbons could bypass the isolation plug requiring further circulation of kill fluid and exposing the workforce to additional hazards. The focus of the Executive in this case is the safety of the workforce and the completion of well operations in a safe and efficient manner and in my opinion would be better served by continuous operations until the abandonment cement plug has been set and tested.

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
