Dear Surrey County Council,

Yesterday at 16:00 we opened the well to commence the abandonment work program. We found the well to be live and decided to run in hole a kill / cementing string straight away and displace the well to heavy fluid.

I asked the well to be displaced using an air pump (quiet) so as not to disturb people at night. This took us into the early hours but it was done very quietly.

Due to safety concerns that the well is live above the existing / old barrier downhole we wish to complete this abandonment section in a timely fashion for safety reasons. Once we have a safe well we shall go back to daylight operations only.

The good news is we hope to now be completed with a safe, sealed and cemented well **within seven days**. Presuming it all goes well. Then we shall back load all equipment which without slow walking should only take 24 to 48 hrs.
