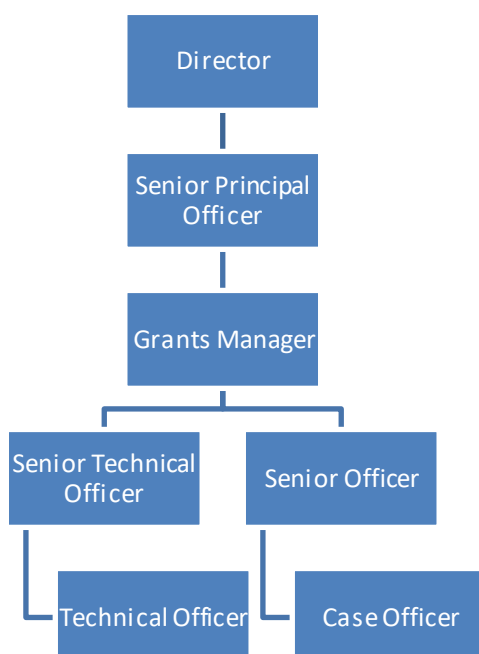
Re: Freedom of Information Act 2000


