Re: Deaths caused by food allergies/allergic reaction

Thank you for your email dated 21 June 2018 addressed to Public Health England (PHE). Your email has been handled as a request for information under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act.

You asked:

I am currently studying an MSC in Environmental Health and my dissertation is on food businesses who fail to protect public health by not offering sufficient or correct allergen information.

I would like to request a figure for the number of deaths caused my allergic reactions to food based allergens in the UK, on an annual basis if you hold this.

In accordance with Section 1(1) (a) of the FOI Act, I can confirm that PHE does not hold the information you have specified.
