Thank you for your request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations (2004), which was logged under 20/746 SOUTH and passed to me to respond accordingly.

Under Part 2 Regulation 5 of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, you are entitled to information which is in the authority's possession or is held by another person on behalf of the authority unless any exceptions apply (Part 3 Regulation 12). I have considered your request and can confirm we do hold the information requested and I do not believe any of the exceptions apply to your request.

Please find below the information you requested (where available):

*I would like to find out the total number of Social/Affordable homes currently administered by SoHa In Highland Park, Henley on Thames RG9 and their exact location on the site.*

*Further I would like to know how many of the proposed buildings on the site will be set aside for Social/Affordable homes and where they will be located on the site.*

Please find attached to this email, along with this letter, plans showing the location of the affordable housing across the entire site, over two planning applications, P17/S0024/RM and P20/S3271/FUL. In combination the plans show 76 affordable housing units out of a total of 191 dwellings.

Please treat this as the council's formal response. If you are not satisfied with the decision I have made in response to your request, under Regulation 11, you may make a request for an internal review within 40 working days of receiving this response by emailing [xxx@xxxxxxxxx.xxx.xx](mailto:xxx@xxxxxxxxx.xxx.xx).
