Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Request – 110480

Thank you for your request dated 23 February 2017 in which you asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ):

The data of the number of claims from (former) staff members brought against Cardiff and Vale University Health Board to Cardiff Employment Tribunal for unfair dismissal (summarily dismissed for gross misconduct) between 2012 to present (2017)

Your request has been handled under the FOIA.

I can confirm that the MoJ holds some of the information that you have requested and I have provided it below.

Having checked our records we do not have records going back to 2012 as these are routinely destroyed/deleted in accordance with the Data Protection Act. However, from the information that is available, I can confirm that we have 10 cases recorded on our system which were received between 2014 to date.
