Thank you for your request under the *Freedom of Information Act 2000* (the Act). This response is provided on behalf of NHS Barnet Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG). Your request along with the CCG's response is detailed below.

NHS Barnet CCG does not hold this information. The total spend will be subsumed within the CCGs overall contract with its local mental health trust, Barnet, Enfield and Haringey Mental Health NHS Trust. The CCG does not hold data on specific diagnoses.
