I wish to object to the appropriation and sale of the land off Arrowe Park Rd adjacent to what is known as Sainsbury's roundabout. I understand this land is being sold to Lidl for use as a carpark for a store they wish on the old Upton Fire Station site. As someone [REDACTED]
