I wish to object to this proposal.

Then Council has passed a motion declaring a climate emergency, yet still persists in prioritising building and car-parking over maintaining green spaces.

We do not need any more retail or parking spaces, and we certainly don't need yet more trees to be destroyed, following the huge numbers already felled. Small corners of land like this are not unimportant just because they are small - or are we going to go on nibbling away at green land till all the remaining pieces are "small", and then destroy the last remnants too. Where does it stop?

The last year has surely shown the value of such small green spaces as green spaces - and also the enormous importance of planning to reduce car-use, not encourage it.
