

I write to object to the sale of land opposite Upton roundabout, to be used as a carpark.

This is the busiest roundabout (on A roads) in the Wirral. Selling this land will increase both traffic congestion and traffic pollution.

This is a "green buffer" in a heavily built up area. Taking away this "green buffer" will increase the concrete jungle.

This area is a buffer for the residents of the Big Meadow Road area, protecting them for traffic noise and pollution. It will also take away a footpath that runs from Big Meadow Road and the supermarket.

Selling this land is contrary to Wirral MBC's declared "Climate Emergency".
