I wish to object to the construction of the Lidl in Upton ref PAR/LHRAM/33687

I have three main objections

1. The addition of another supermarket will compound the issues we have seen in Upton Village. Since Sainsbury's has opened the number of local businesses that were squeezed out and forced to shut has been detrimental to local business. Adding another supermarket will likely mean it will be even more difficult for local businesses to thrive.
2. The increased traffic this will bring to the roundabout. It is dangerous enough as it is and will likely bring more cars, pollution and noise which is not inline with the Council's climate emergency and is going to be to the detriment of local residents.
