In line with PHE policy, responsibility for making decisions on data access requests formally rests with the relevant Information Asset Owner (IAO) with advice and approvals provided as appropriate by the Senior Information Risk Owner and Caldicott Guardian. Robust protocols and procedures ensure that all data releases comply with current legal and policy frameworks.

The Data Release Assurance Board (DRAB) provides operational support to the IAOs in exercising this responsibility. In so doing, it is accountable to the Chief Executive (as the PHE Accountable Officer), who has final, overall responsibility for ensuring that information risks are appropriately managed and mitigated.

The Office for Data Release (ODR) is responsible for managing the release of explicitly identifiable or potentially identifiable data on behalf of the Information Asset Owner to an agreed process and within a formal structure.
