## Freedom of Information Request - RFI20171839

Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) dated 8 December, seeking the following information:

Thank you for your response to my enquiry. However, you have not answered it. 'Can you tell me if the BBC generally or any department or person is bound by the Official Secrets Act. If so, could you please identify who is covered.'

I have not asked who has 'signed" the Official Secrets Act (as I understand it signing is not necessary anyway) but whether any particular department or person (as in class of person) is bound by the act.

No department as a whole or 'class of person' is required to sign the Official Secrets Act.
