1) Does the NAO monitor whether ORR publishes its Board minutes on time?

For the purpose of carrying out the audit, the NAO reviews Board minutes obtained directly from ORR. The NAO does not have a role in monitoring whether Board minutes are published on the ORR website on-time by the ORR.

2) Did ORR notify the NAO that the ORR Board minutes had not been published since the minutes of the meeting of 22 September 2020?

We can confirm that the ORR did not notify the NAO that it had not published Board minutes on its website.
