- 2. How many applications resulted in a work experience placement? No applications received
- 3. What is the minimum age for work experience in Orthoptics? Minimum age of 16
- 4. Do applicants for work experience in Orthoptics require a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check? Work shadow applicants do not need a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check, as they are accompanied at all times
- **5. What paperwork are applicants required to complete?** Prospective applicants complete an application form, references are required
- **6.** Are applicants required to complete an induction? Applicants will receive local induction and instructions of confidentiality.
