INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS ATTENDING HYSTEROSCOPY CLINIC FOR AN ENDOMETRIAL BIOPSY

You have just had an Endometrial biopsy. An Endometrial Biopsy is a sample of tissue taken from the lining of the womb and this is sent to the laboratory for analysis.

A – You may experience some vaginal loss for up to 5 days.

B – Take things easy for the rest of the day. You may return to work and normal activities tomorrow.

C – If you feel any discomfort, take a mild pain killer.

It is recommended that you:

1 – Have daily baths /showers

2 – Use sanitary pads - NOT tampons.

3 – Avoid intercourse until the bleeding or discharge has completely stopped.
