I am writing to confirm your appointment for you to attend the Menstrual Disorder Clinic at (HOSP NAME) on (OPDTIME) at (OPATIME)

On arrival please proceed straight to THE HANOVER BUILDING, WOMEN'S HEALTH DEPARTMENT on the ground floor.

You will be seen by the consultant who will take a history and discuss with you the reason for the referral. During the appointment if you havent already had one you will be given an internal scan. If necessary following this the consultant will offer a hysteroscopy. This test involves inserting a thin instrument called a hysteroscope gently through the cervix and into the uterine cavity. This will assess the lining of the womb and check for the presence of polyps. During the procedure warmed fluid is passed through the hysteroscope so that the lining can be viewed clearly. The procedure is not generally painful however, some women may experience a little discomfort therefore you may want to ask someone to accompay you. Most hysteroscopy procedures take less than 5 minutes, the whole appointment can take about 40 minutes.

If for any reason you are unable to attend please call the above telephone number so we can reschedule your appointment to another patient. If, for medical reasons you need an ambulance to attend the hospital, please contact your G.P. approximately one week before your appointment is due, who will arrange transport.
