I would be most grateful if you would provide me, under the Freedom of Information Act, details in respect to the contract below. Oxfordshire CCG Community Ultrasound and Echocardiography Service.		
Suppliers who applied for inclusion on each framework/contract and were successful & not successful at the PQQ & ITT stages	Ultrasound: We had applications from Bestcare, Curx, Diagnostic Healthcare, Global Diagnostics, Health Harmonie, Mediscan, Physiological Measurements and Surgimed. The tender was run using an "open" process meaning there weren't separate PQQ and ITT stages so all providers submitted tenders. Diagnostics Healthcare's bid was non-compliant and excluded without being scored, and Curx did not pass the financial evaluation meaning their bid was also excluded before being scored. Of the remaining tenders Physiological Measurements Ltd was the highest scoring bidder. Echocardio: We had four applications, from Harmonic, Inhealth, Oxford University Hospitals NHS Trust and Physiological Measurements. Harmonic's bid was over the permitted budget and was excluded from consideration. Of the remaining three, Inhealth Ltd was the highest scoring bidder.
