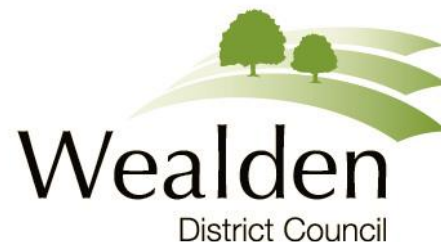

OUTCOME

We are writing in response to your request for information received on 18th August 2021. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Thank you for your request for information. We have processed your request and your questions together with our corresponding responses are as follows:

1. *How many Blue Badge holders are in your area?*
Wealden District Council does not provide the services you seek information on, therefore we do not hold any information in relation to the questions you ask. We are therefore unable to answer this question.

We can advise you that East Sussex County Council would be the appropriate Authority to provide these services for the Wealden District and we have provided a link to their Freedom of Information page [here](#).

2. *How many council-owned parking spaces there are?*
Wealden District Council own 1883 car parking spaces. We would highlight that on street parking is the responsibility of East Sussex County Council.
3. *How many of these council-owned parking spaces are for Blue Badge holders?*
68 disabled car park spaces
4. *How many of these council-owned parking spaces are parent-child spaces?*
6 parent and child spaces
5. *How many fines are, on average, given out, to those that park in Blue Badge spaces that aren't allowed to park there?*
278 Excess Charge Notices were issued over the last 2 years
6. *The same for parent-child spaces.*
