Response to Request for Information - 929105

Pay and Display Transactions and Income

I can confirm that the information requested is held by Wolverhampton Council. I have detailed below the information, in blue, that is being released to you.

Request

Where the council is responsible for On-Street and Off Street pay and display car parking (excluding Off-Street pay-on-foot and pay-on-exit car parks, permits, season tickets, PCN and other income)

For the period 01/04/2018 to 31/03/2019, please could you tell me:

1. The total number of Off Street pay and display parking transactions/tickets sold (all payment methods)

The total number Off-street Pay and Display ticket transactions in the period 01/04/2018 to 31/03/2019 is 687,787.

2. The total number of On Street pay and display parking transactions/tickets sold (all payment methods)

As 30% of our On-street Pay and Display machines do not provide this detail it is not possible to provide the figure for the total number of On-street transactions.

- 3. Total Off Street pay and display income (all payment methods)
 The total income generated from Off-street Pay and Display parking, in the period 01/04/2018 to 31/03/2019, is £1,598,434
- 4. Total On Street pay and display income (all payment methods)
 The total income generated from On-street Pay and Display parking, in the period 01/04/2018 to 31/03/2019, is £478,348
- 5. Total number of Off Street pay and display parking transactions/tickets sold via a pay by phone provider e.g. RingGo
