Dear Mr Douglas

Thank you for your email of 16 August in which you requested the 'table of contents' for the Army Field Manual War Fighting Tactics Part 5a: Armoured and Armoured Infantry Sub Unit Tactics doctrine. I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act).

This request was made following your earlier request (FOI2019/08228) in which you asked to see a copy of the above doctrine, as well as the Health Service Support to Land Operations Handbook. I explained in my letter dated 16 August that this information was exempt for release under Section 14 of the Act (Vexatious and Burdensome) due to the volume requested and that, if released, much would fall under Section 26 of the Act (Defence).

The Contents of the Army Field Manual War Fighting Tactics Part 5a is attached to this letter and can be found at Annex A. Because you have stated that you are asking for the Contents in order to make a more targeted request, I do wish to reiterate the point made in my previous letter that significant amounts of information in this document would fall under Section 26 (Defence) of the Act and, subject to a public interest test, are likely to be withheld.

If you have any queries regarding the content of this letter, please contact this office in the first instance. Following this, if you wish to complain about the handling of your request, or the content of this response, you can request an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review should be made within 40 working days of the date of this response.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may raise your complaint directly to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
