### **Freedom of Information Request:**

Thank you for your freedom of information request dated 3 November 2018.

I am looking into finding out about the location of pedestrian crossings in North Lincolnshire. Please could you provide me with the following:

1. A list of all the different pedestrian crossing within North Lincolnshire boundaries. Including the location of all formal crossings; Zebra, Toucan, Pegasus, Staggered Pelican/Puffin and Toucan crossings.

**Details provided in Appendix 1**

2. Information on the type of tactile pavings used at each site.

**Controlled crossings – red tactile pavers are used.**

3. A list of all lowered kerbs in North Lincolnshire district. Showing location of each and paying particular attention to the ones intended for use as pedestrian crossing points.

**These records are not available and the cost of gathering this information would exceed the agreed thresholds given in the guidance for Freedom of Information Requests.**

4. The above would ideally include the use of the GeoCoordinate system information of each site, but also the street name and location.
