Freedom of Information Act 2000

This request is being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I am writing to inform you that we have searched our records and some of the information you requested is not held by Sefton Council. No information is held on the type of tactile paving used at each formal crossing site, this information could be accessed through Google Streetview, No information is held on the location of lowered kerbs which are not at formal crossing points

I have enclosed copies of the information that is held.

- 1) A list of all the different pedestrian crossings within Sefton Council boundaries. Including the location of all formal crossings: Zebra, Toucan, Pegasus, Staggered Pelican/Puffin and Toucan crossings.

Two spreadsheets are attached one showing locations of zebra crossings and the other showing the locations of all other types of formal crossing

- 2) Information on the type of tactile paving used at each site.

The Council does not hold this information but as we have supplied location details for all formal crossings you may be able to gain this information through looking at the sites on Google Streetview.

- 3) A list of all lowered kerbs in the Sefton Council district. Showing the location of each and paying particular attention to the ones intended for use as pedestrian crossing points.

The Council does not hold this information.

- 4) The above would ideally include the use of the Geocoordinate system information of each site, but also the street name and location.

Co-ordinates have been given for the formal crossings listed in the two spreadsheets
