### **Your request:**

#### **Pedestrian Crossings with White Globe Beacon**

I am looking to find out the locations of Pedestrian 'Centre Island' crossings in Ealing Borough Council. Please can you provide me with the following information:

- 1) A list of all the pedestrian crossings marked with a white centre island globe beacon within Ealing Borough Council boundaries.
- 2) Information on how many 'White centre island globe beacons' on each crossing point.
- 3) The above would ideally include the use of the Geo-coordinate system information of each site, but also the street name and location.

The information will be used to provide a complete map of the District to aid in the navigation of Ealing Borough Council for pedestrians.
