Dear Mr Wilkinson,

Thank you for your email of 13 September 2016, in which you request:

"I request a copy of Petroleum and Development Licence 261 issued to Aurora Energy Resources in December 2015."

We have considered your requests in accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIRs). However, to the extent that any of the information requested may not be environmental, we have also considered your requests under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). Accordingly, your requests have been dealt with under the terms of the EIRs and the FOIA.

Under FOIA you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the FOIA which may apply).

Between you submitting your request and us processing it, the Petroleum Exploration and Development License (PEDL) in question (PEDL 261) has been executed and is now on the OGA website.
