The access point is marked X on the attached map.

We estimate around 4000t of timber to be extracted from the site from the south side of the Machany Road then onto the A823.

There is a woods track and access into the woods off the Machany public road; at the moment it is a 12ft gate and we intend to upgrade this to a wider bell-mouth for lorries to turn in to the wood safely. Are you ok with this?

The timber will be loaded from the wood track, not the main road. We haven't appointed a timber contractor yet, not wanting to pre-empt the felling license, so I can't tell when the timber would be extracted.

Directly to the north of the Crofthead wood is Drumness Wood & this was recently felled & a wider access created, similar to what we intend to do on the south side of the Machany road:

Thank you for your email asking for my views on the timber haulage route from the Machany road to the A823.

Could you give me some information in relation to the timber felling licence?

1. What is the anticipated tonnage to be harvested from the site?
2. How many loads per week would be leaving the site?
3. Is the access point from the woods onto the public road on the north or south side of the road or is a new access going to be formed?

Once the timber lorries get on to the A823 road then there is not a problem as it is an “agreed route” by the STTTG but I would need this additional information in order to get an idea of the extra timber traffic loading that this unclassified road might be expected to take.
