Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Information in relation to criteria for accessing the Trusts Personality Disorder Services

I am writing to confirm that the South Eastern Health & Social Care Trust (the Trust) has previously provided the information relating to Personality Disorder Services criteria which you requested on 8 June 2016.

In your previous request RFI 16754(DG), the response issued by the Trust on 22 April 2016 (copy attached) provided the inclusion criteria for a client to be offered Dialectical Behaviour Therapy Services. I can confirm that the same inclusion criterion is applied for clients accessing the Personality Disorder Department Services. The only Personality Disorder services provided by the Trust are Comprehensive Dialectical Behaviour Therapy and Dialectical Behaviour Therapy Skills only Group, as outlined in the above mentioned Trust response.

Under the terms of the legislation, if you are unhappy with this response you have the right to seek a review within the Trust in the first instance. If you wish to do so, please write to me at the address below.

If after such a review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner who will undertake an independent review.
