Information Request

Thank you for your request for information, which was received on the 4 December 2017.

As this is a request for environmental information, it has been handled in accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR). EIR is broadly similar to the Freedom of Information Act, but specifically applies to environmental information.

In response to your request, in which you sought the following information:

Brislands Lane

Please provide copies of all information regarding the agreement now reached with the Developer as to the 'final' extent of the highway improvements in Brislands Lane. This should include, but not be restricted to the following:

---- the DETAILED contract drawings required by Schedule 2 [1.1] of the s.278 Agreement for Phase 2 of the Works and the "... creation of an emergency access... on Brislands Lane ... as shown in principle on Drawing 212433/118 dated October 2013."; and ---- record of any consultation/negotiation regarding the above, including that with East Hampshire District Council, the fire service, Building Regulations, SSEN, local councillors and/or the Developer [or Developer's Approved Inspector, Premier Guarantee Surveyors].

Below is the response to the points that you have raised.

Please find attached copies of two (all) items of information relevant to your enquiry. Please note that neither the submission of the plan nor the acceptance of the proposal have been submitted or processed pursuant to Schedule 2 1 [1.1] of the s278 agreement. The approval is already in place and these items simply confirm the scope of works and document minor amendments previously agreed on site.

Under Regulations 12(3) and 13(2)(a)(i) EIR personal information about a third party has been redacted from the attached records, as disclosure of the information would constitute unfair and unlawful processing of their information in breach of the first principle of the Data Protection Act 1998.

As one further comment on your enquiry, I would highlight that all contract drawings submitted to meet the requirements of the Schedule, and the Council's subsequent approval, were previously supplied to you on 10 May 2017 (Ref EIR 12163). It is unclear, therefore, how you reach the conclusion that "NO relevant details have been submitted".
