Apologies for not getting back to you.

Happy with the extent of surfacing, however I am concerned about planning off the existing carriageway surface. Firstly I'm not sure what the existing makeup is? Imagine the thickness is not significant. In addition, during the works, serious concern was raised by the resident at the property on the southern side of Brislands Lane, in that any mechanical dig was affecting his house foundations. Therefore, I think overlaying the existing carriageway surface would be a better option then an inlay, primarily to avoid any full carriageway reconstruction works.

With regards to a works start, if you could get your contractor to supply their proposed TM, programme and anticipated works start date. Imagine a road closure will be required?
